Alliance for True Democracy Releases the Poll Result of September

The Alliance for True Democracy (ATD) requested the Public Opinion Programme of the University of Hong Kong to conduct a survey in September, to gauge citizens' opinions on the "Three Tracks Nomination Proposal" proposed by the ATD.

The survey was a telephone interview survey, telephone numbers were selected randomly. The support rate for the "Three Tracks Nomination Proposal" was 44%, which is significantly higher than the opposing rate of 15%. On a 0 to 10 point scale, the proposal received 5.9 points in support on the average. ATD believes the result show that Hong Kong people have not given up the proposal that can introduce genuine choices for the Chief Executive Election, even though the NPCSC decision does not allow Hong Kong people meaningful choices. It shows the determination of Hong Kong people to fight for a democratic electoral system with no political screening.
